Rules & Information

Entry Forms and Fees to be submitted No Later than 4pm Sunday August 30th 2015 – NO EXCEPTIONS!

The Post Box will be available in the pub for your entry forms and entrance money from mid July 2015.

Entry Fees: Open 30p per exhibit. Children 20p per exhibit.

Entry Forms will be available in the pub and can be downloaded from www.crownandsceptrestroud.com

1. No more than 3 entries per person in any one class. In the event of an excess of entries, this will be further limited to 1 entry per person per class. The organisers will post information about this should it become necessary.

2. All entries other than Section D (43-47) and Sections F (63-67) must be the produce of the exhibitor.

3. Entries for the Children's Section must display the exhibitor's age.

4. No exhibitors names to be displayed.

5. Where possible, and appropriate, please place exhibits on a paper plate.

6. Vegetables should be trimmed, where appropriate, so that tops are no more than 50mm.

7. The Organisers accept no responsibility for loss or damage.

8. Entries to be placed in marquee between 10am and 12 Noon on Saturday 5th Sept.

9. Each entrant will be provided with a personal number, designating his or her exhibition space.

10. Judging will take place between 12 Noon and 2.30pm.

11. Points will be awarded as follows: $1^{st} - 7$ points, $2^{nd} - 4$ points, $3^{rd} - 2$ points.

12. Prizes will be presented between 4pm-5pm.

13. Exhibitors who wish to remove their entries may do so following the presentation of prizes.

14. Any entries left after this time will be auctioned for charity.

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Section A Floral Decorations (Open)

Competition Cup Sponsored by STROUD BREWERY 1. Flowers and foliage not to exceed 300mm overall, displayed in a vase.

2. Flower arrangement of any 3 blooms of the same variety with foliage.

3. Flower arrangement with accessories, to represent a pub sign, not to exceed 500mm overall.

4. Arrangement in an unusual container, any plant material, not to exceed 500mm overall.

5. Table centrepiece not to exceed 500mm overall.

6. A vase of weeds not to exceed 500mm overall.

Section B Flowers (Open)

8. Roses, 3 blooms any variety, in a container.

11. Vase of Dahlias, any variety, maximum of 5. 12. Pot plant, flowering or foliage, not to exceed 500mm.

13. Geraniums/Pelargoniums in a pot.

Vegetables (Open)

15. Beetroot, 3 round or long, trimmed tops.

16. Carrots, 6 long pointed, trimmed tops.

17. Carrots, 6 any other variety than long, trimmed tops.

18. Longest carrot, trimmed top.

19. Courgettes, 3 not to exceed 150mm in length.
